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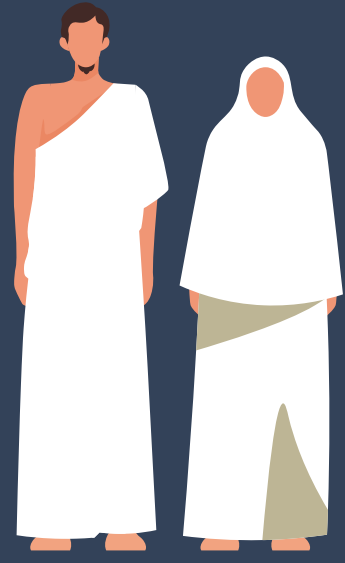
HAJJ OVERVIEW

TAMATTU HAJJ

A person travelling from outside the Miqaat (boundaries), puts on Ihraam and makes the niyyat of Umrah only, in the months of Hajj. After completing the Umrah, i.e. Tawaaf and Sa’ee, he comes out of Ihraam by making halaq (shaving the head, etc.). Thereafter, he puts on the Ihraam from Makkah Mukarramah and makes Niyyat of Hajj only.

Oh Allāh, I am intending to make 'Umrah, so make it easy for me & accept the 'Umrah from me.

Recite the Talbiyah x 3 - Durood x 3 and thereafter make Dua.
Recite the Talbiyah and any form of Dhikr until you reach Makkah.

In Ihram, you are not permitted to smoke, swear, shave, clip your nails, engage in sexual relations. Fighting & arguments are forbidden, participants are prohibited from hunting, killing, or unjustifiably breaking anything. You must also avoid scented products such as perfumes, moisturisers, makeup, or soaps.

Remember! Always protect your gaze, especially in Ihraam or when in the Haram. It is not permissible to talk unnecessarily to any ghayr-mahram woman, especially if it is merely to make conversation.

Tawāf must be made in the state of wudhu.

Go to Hajar al-Aswad (black stone). The Hajar al-Aswad must be in line with your left shoulder.

Make niyyah for Tawāf:



Men - Make sure your right shoulder is open for the 7 laps of tawaaf, thereafter you may cover it.

2 TAWAF

Face Hajar al-Aswad and raise both the hands in line with the shoulders, while reciting the takbīr,

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَ اللَّهِ الْحَمْدُ

Face the palms of both the hands in the direction of the Hajar al-Aswad and thereafter kiss both the hands.

Begin the Tawāf. Your body must not face the Ka'bah at any time during the Tawāf.

In the **first three rounds men only** will walk with a brisk pace and chest out = ramal. In the remaining four rounds they will walk normally.

Complete a total of 7 rounds anti-clockwise, starting and ending at the black stone. Be sure to encircle the Haṭīm, otherwise the Tawāf will be incomplete.

Engage yourself in any du'ā while making Tawāf. - Any Language

Any Tawāf you make after this is nafl. You are not required to have on Ihrām and you do not have to make ramal in the first three rounds.

There is also no sa'ee after nafl Tawāf. All other things will remain the same.

If you wish to make an 'Umrah again you may do so. Head towards Masjid 'Āiṣhah to don Ihrām and follow 'umrah notes from above



Now that you've performed your Umrah, for the rest of this blessed month, you'll stay in Makkah or Aziziyah to complete your spiritual journey of Hajj.

Make the best use of your time by performing sincere acts of worship. Your Hajj will begin on the 8th Dhul Hijjah.

Arrive in the tent city of Mina, settle into your tent. Here you'll pray 5 Salah including Dhuhr, Asr, Maghrib, 'Isha and Fajr. Spend your time in Salaah, Tilaawah, du'aa and zikr.

After Fajr Salaah - Recite Talbiya x 3 and Durood x3



Tip: Be patient in Mina, space inside the tents can be very tight, and you might find yourself very close to fellow pilgrims. The weather is likely to be very hot, so remember to keep yourself hydrated.

Recite abundant Zikr, Istigfaar and Talbiya

Tip: Try to use the bathroom before peak periods (salaah times) and in the morning. Carry a bag with hook, so you can hang your items

ARAFAH



After sunrise, leave for 'Arafah, reciting Istaghfar and dua. It is Waajib to be in Arafah till sunset.

The time of Wuqoof at Arafah begins only after Zawaal.



It is Waajib upon males and females to read the Takbeer Tashreeq after every Fardh salaah from Fajr on the 9th till Asr on the 13th Zil Hijjah

Perform Zuhr and 'Asr as normal. ***It is not permissible to read Jumuah salaah in 'Arafah. Zuhr should be read instead.***
Remain in 'Arafah up to sunset.

There is no day on which Allah frees servants of His from Fire more than (those freed on) the Day of 'Arafah



Take full advantage of being in Arafah. Allah Ta'ala has given you an opportunity of repenting and returning as pure as a new-born baby. Stand facing the Qiblah, spread your hands and exert yourself in dua for yourself, family and the whole Ummah. Exert yourself in Taubah (repentance) and Istighfar (begging for forgiveness). Constantly read the Talbiyah (Labbaik). Remember that in dua most important is the heart and presence of mind. Most important in dua is being conscious and sincere. Dua should be from the heart.



Intermingling of sexes is Haraam, particularly at these sacred places. It is absolutely necessary to guard ones eyes, particularly in Arafah because it can lead to being deprived of Allah Ta'ala's Mercies.

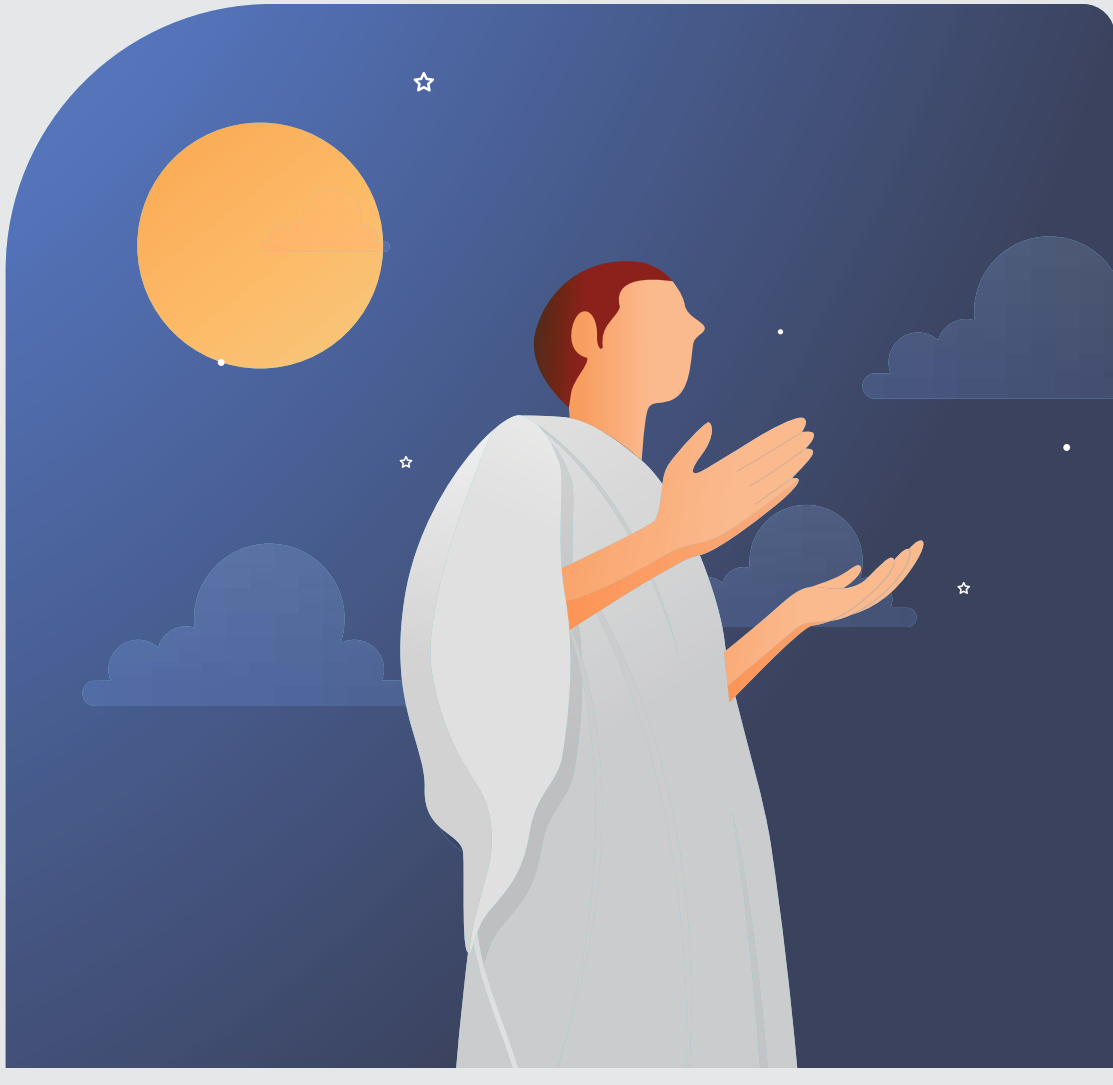

After sunset, depart 'Arafah and head to Muzdalifah without reading Maghrib. At Muzdalifah perform your Maghrib and 'Esha Salah, one after the other



Niyyah for Maghrib is **ADA** not **QADHA**

Perform Maghrib & Esha as follows:

Adhaan - Iqaamah

3 Rakaats Fardh of Maghrib + read the Takbeer-e-Tashreeq

4 Rakaats Fardh of Esha

- thereafter Sunnats of Maghrib

- and Sunnats of Esha

**Jamaat is not a condition for combining the two salaah here.*

Collect pebbles to perform Rami (stoning of the devil) over the next three days. You will need a total of 49 pebbles. It is advised to pick up additional 21 pebbles, bringing a total of 70 pebbles.

10 th Zul Hijjah	7 Pebbles - Pelting Aqabah - Large Jamarah Only
11 th Zul Hijjah	21 Pebbles - Pelting all 3 Jamarah
12 th Zul Hijjah	21 Pebbles - Pelting all 3 Jamarah
13 th Zul Hijjah	21 Pebbles - Pelting all 3 Jamarah (If you stay the additional day in Mina)



At Muzdalifah, you will stay under the night sky. No tents or accommodation.

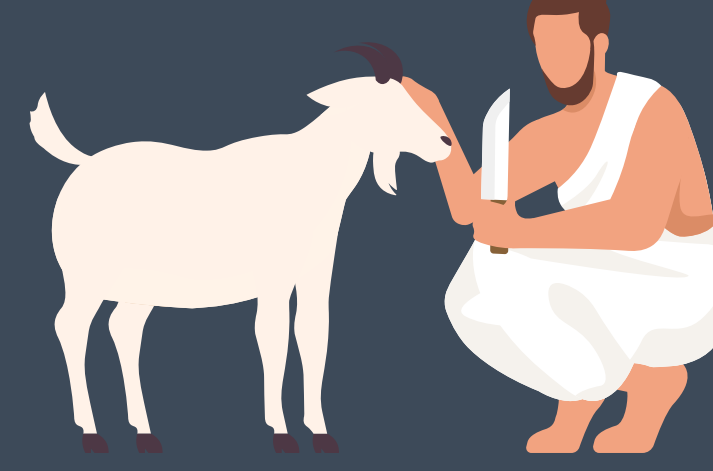
There are Toilets/Wudhu facilities, but will be crowded so exercise patience. Recommend you use the toilets before you leave 'Arafah.

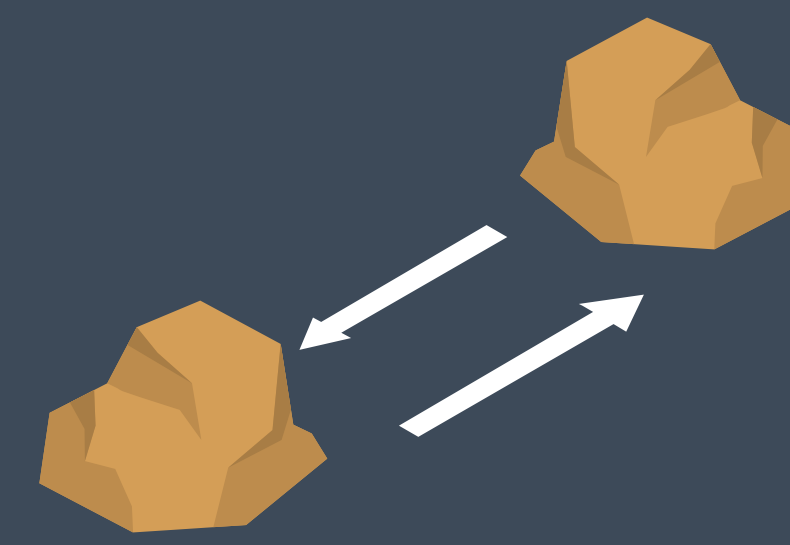

RAMI (PELTING OF SHAYTAAN)

WAAJIB



On the 10th, only the Jamaratul Aqabah should be pelted.
Talbiyah should be stopped when the first stone is pelted.
Recite the following when pelting:

RECITE THE FOLLOWING WHEN PELTING

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ، رَغْمًا لِلشَّيْطَانِ وَرِضًا لِلرَّحْمَنِ
اللَّهُمَّ اجْعَلْهُ حَجًّا مَبْرُورًا وَذَنْبًا مَغْفُورًا وَسَعْيًا مَشْكُورًا

*In the name of Allah, Allah is Great. In spite of Satan and to please the Merciful.
O Allah make this an accepted Hajj, with sins forgiven and the effort rewarded*

QURBANI

WAAJIB



After pelting, slaughtering an animal is WAAJIB - Dam-e-Shukr
By offering Qurbani (sacrifice), Muslims mark Prophet Ibrahim's (AS) willingness to sacrifice his son Isma'il (AS) upon the commandment of Allah (SWT).



Remember to perform your regular Qurbani back home. This is separate to your Hajj Qurbani - Dam-e-Shukr

HALAQ - SHAVING OF THE HAIR

WAAJIB

Shave the entire head, starting from the right side - MEN ONLY
Women will cut off about 2cm off the bottom of their hair.

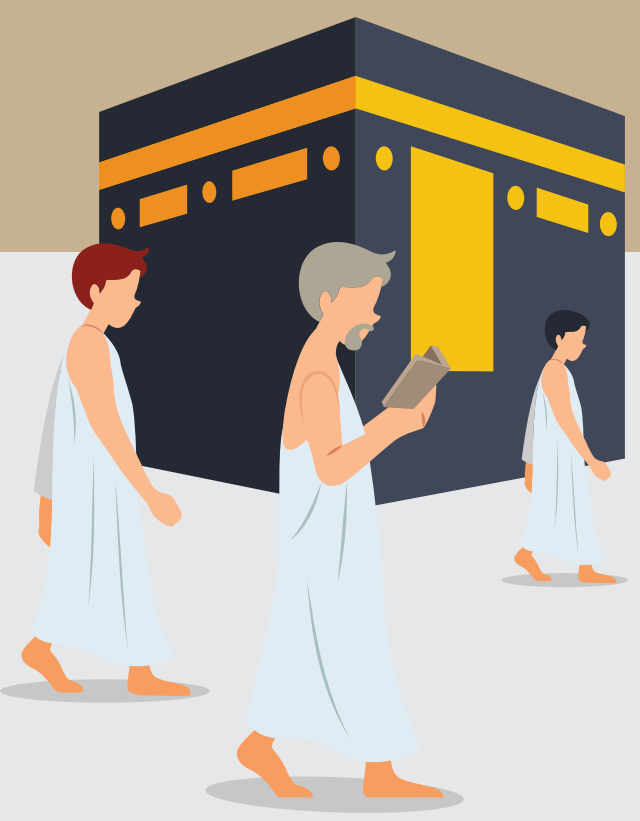


Once complete, you may come out of Ihraam



Everything prohibited because of being in Ihraam becomes permissible except sexual relationship and acts that can lead to it.

TAWAAF-E-ZIYAARAT

RUKN

This Tawaaf is Fardh in Hajj. The manner of doing this Tawaaf is exactly the same as any other Tawaaf.

INTENTION FOR TAWĀF

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أُرِيدُ طَوَافَ بَيْتِكَ الْحَرَامِ فَيَسِّرْهُ لِي
وَتَقَبَّلْهُ مِنِّي

Oh Allāh, I intend performing the Tawāf of Your Sacred House, so make my Tawāf easy for me & accept it from me

Face Hajar al-Aswad and raise both the hands in line with the shoulders, while reciting the takbīr,

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَاللَّهُ أَحْمَدُ

Face the palms of both the hands in the direction of the Hajar al-Aswad and thereafter kiss both the hands.

Begin the Tawāf. Your body must not face the Ka'bah at any time during the Tawāf.

In the **first three rounds men only** will walk with a brisk pace and chest out = ramal. In the remaining four rounds they will walk normally.

Complete a total of 7 rounds anti-clockwise, starting and ending at the black stone. Be sure to encircle the Haṭīm, otherwise the Tawāf will be incomplete.

Engage yourself in any du'ā while making Tawāf. - Any Language

PERFORM 2 RAKA'ĀT WĀJIB AL-TAWĀF

Head towards the Maqām Ibrāhīm or any area in line with it (if there is no
space then anywhere in the masjid.) Recite:

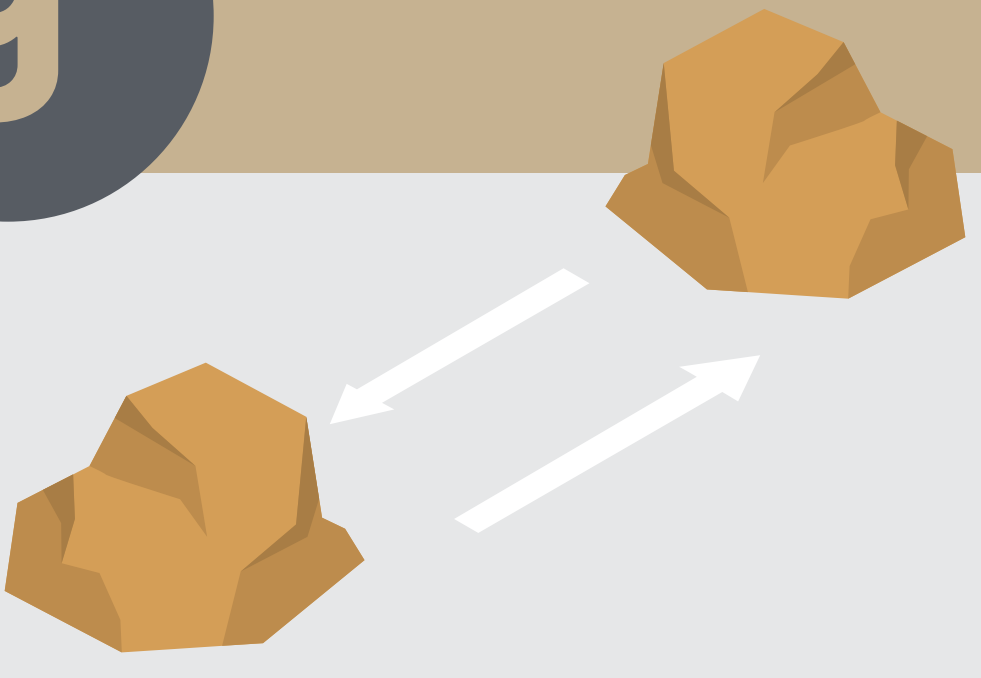

Perform 2 raka'āt Wājib al-Tawāf. Men must cover both shoulders.

- 1st raka'āt: **Sūrah al-Kāfirūn** - 2nd raka'āt: **Sūrah al-Ikhlaas**

Ensure that it is not a makrūh time of Salāh .

Drink Zam Zam and make du'ā (Nabi (S.A.W) said that Zam Zam is for
that intention for which it is drunk)



Sa'ee consists of seven rounds starting at Safaa and ending at Marwa. Safaa to Marwa will be counted as one round

Head towards Safā
Make niyyah for sa'ee

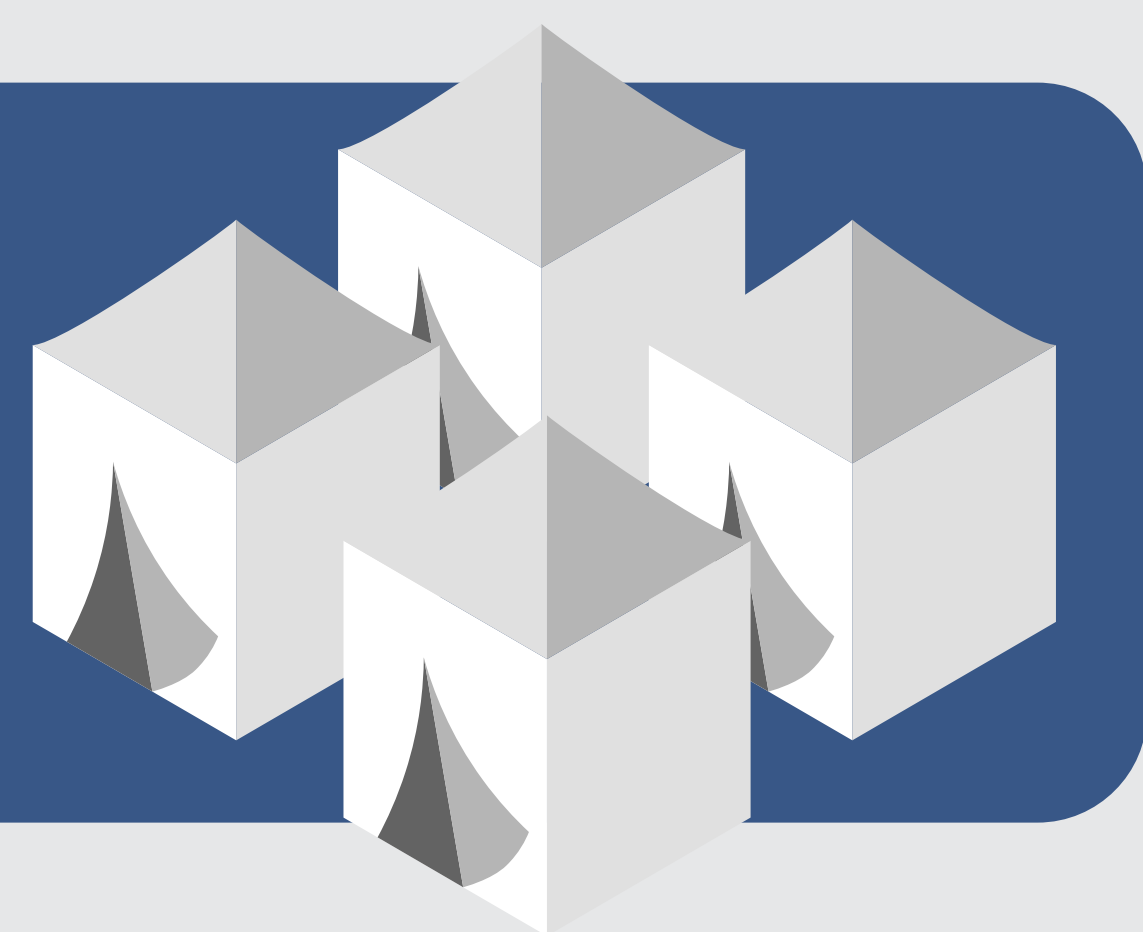

At the top of Marwah face the Qiblah and make du'ā.
This is one round. You will complete seven rounds ending at Marwa.

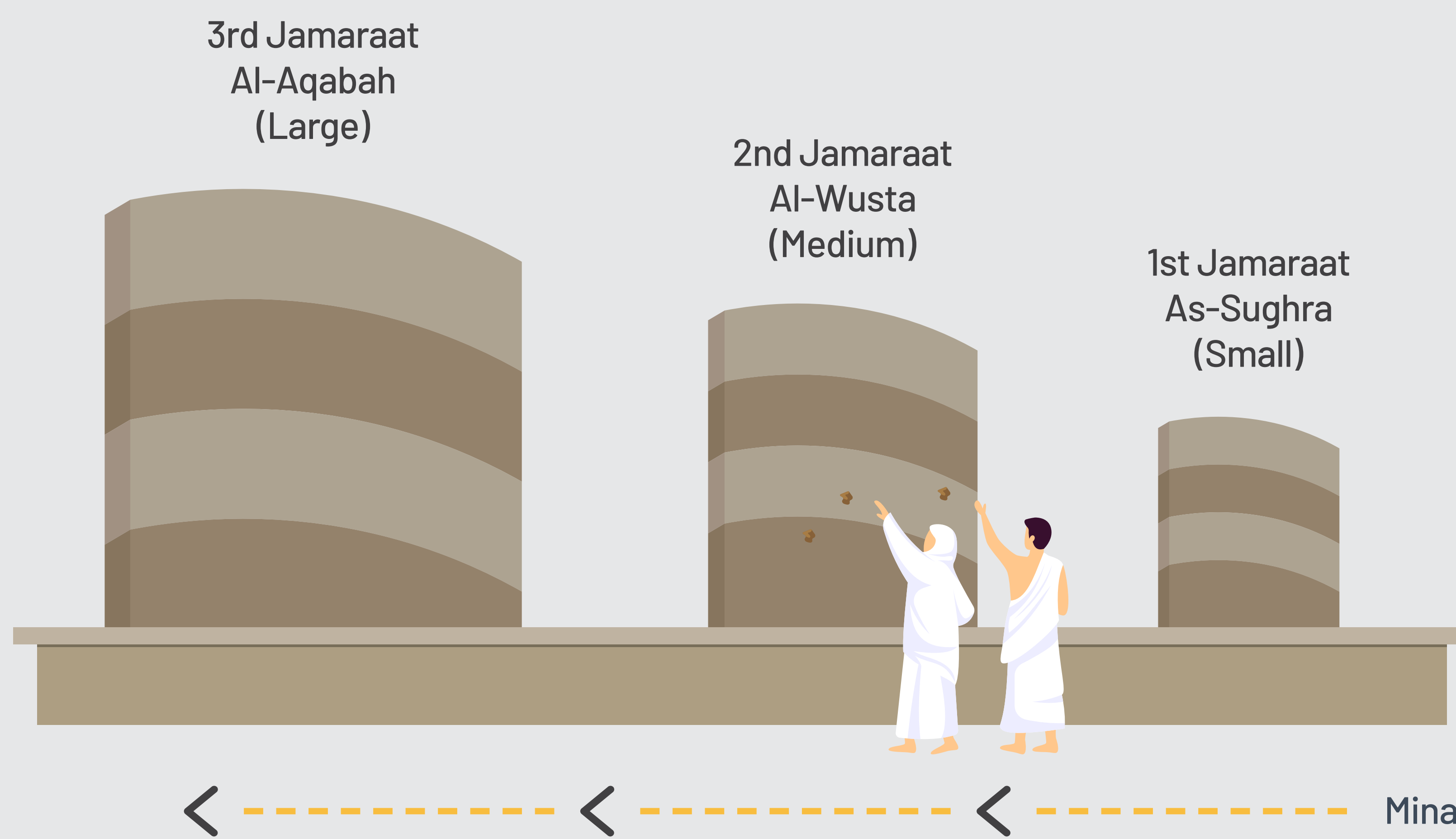


AFTER TAWAAF AND SA'EE RETURN TO MINA.



The time of pelting on the 11th and 12th is between Zawaal and Subh Saadiq, but it is Makrooh to pelt after sunset. On this day and the days after this all three Jamaraat must be pelted.

After pelting the seven stones at the first Jamara, take a few steps back, face the Qibla and make duaa. Do this at the middle Jamara too as du'as are accepted at these places.



It is not Makrooh for women, the sick/weak to delay pelting till after sunset. If a person pelts after the time has expired, then one damm of penalty will become Waajib.



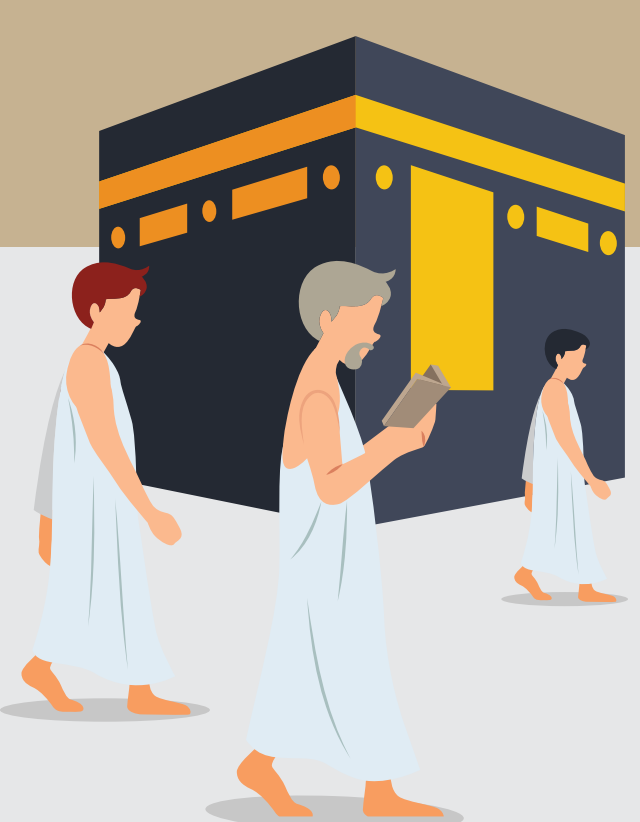
It is Makrooh to leave Mina after sunset. And if one is still in Mina at the time of Subh Saadiq on the 13th, then it becomes Waajib to pelt on the 13th.

It is preferable to stay in Mina till the 13th. The Thawaab is great and for every stone pelted one **major sin is forgiven**.

All three Jamaraat should be pelted on this day.

According to many Ulema, it is permissible to pelt immediately after Subh Saadiq. However, it is better to wait till after Zawaal.

TAWAAF-UL-WIDAA (FAREWELL)

WAAJIB

This Tawaaf is Waajib upon every Hajee not residing in Makkah Mukarramah. Any Tawaaf made after the Tawaaf of Ziyaarat will suffice for the Tawaaf-e-Widaa, even if the intention of Widaa is not made.

USEFUL INFORMATION



Download the Nusuk app before you get to Saudi.

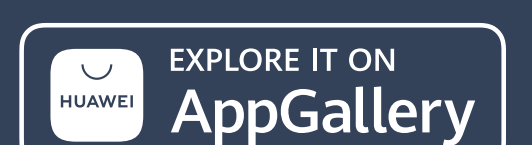
You will use the app to book **Raudah Visits & also Umrah**

** Requirements: Passport No + Visa*

Males: Book your Raudah Visit on the app, then join the queue

Salami: No booking is required

Females: You will have to make a booking for Raudah & Salami visits



Download the Haramain Train app.

You can use the app to book **train tickets from Jeddah/Makkah/Madinah**

- Try not to arrive close to Salaah times, as during peak periods it will be difficult to get close to the Haram as the police close off the roads.
- 1 x Large Bag + 1 x Hand Luggage is allowed
- You have to pay for the trolley (SR5) and the porter (SR15)
- Keep a light jacket/jersey – Aircons blow quite cold
- During peak periods taxi fares will be steep (SR100+)
- Use Uber/Careem as an alternate to the taxi

Madinah to Makkah - 2.5hrs

Jeddah to Makkah - 45mins

TAXI SERVICES



Taxis - Always negotiate before you enter the Taxi

Download Uber or Careem as an alternative form of transport

** When arriving at Salaah times, roads to the Haram will be closed and you will be billed additionally for the time.*

MONEY EXCHANGE

There are many money exchanges around Makkah/Madinah

TIP: Change larger sums, as the lines can be quite long during peak periods

You can also purchase goods at Bin Dawood in dollars (USD) and receive change in Riyals (SAR)

Most stores also accepts Visa/Mastercard

INTERNET DATA/SIM CARD

You can get a Saudi SIM card for 30 SAR (8 USD) in the official stores of the mobile operators (STC, Mobily, Zain). Hajj and Umrah SIM cards start from 34.50 SAR (9.20 USD) – the same applies to visitor SIM cards. Airports sell SIM cards too.

- Use a VPN to get around this (Windscribe / VPN Proxy Master Lite)
- Download IMO, Zoom or Microsoft Team for video calls

VACCINATIONS – Covid + meningitis + Yellow Fever (Yellow Card)

TRAVEL INSURANCE – TIP: You can get Free travel insurance with FNB if you use your credit card

CREDIT CARD – Activate for international use
TIP: Most stores use “tap” cards for payment, so its a convenient method of payment.

FOREX – TIP: Purchase USD as you will get a better rate in Saudi as opposed to changing Rands. Make use of FNB global account.

ISLAMIC WILL – Prepare 2 originals of all your documents
TRAVEL WILL

EMAIL ALL DOCUMENTS – Send yourself a copy of your passport, flights, hotel accomodation, Vaccinations. Make sure to download it onto your phone incase you dont have internet access.
